


Coming Together, Keeping Together, & Working Together for Success

The International Day of Friendship, celebrated annually on July 30, reminds us of the importance of fostering friendships among people, nations, and cultures in promoting peace, diversity, understanding, and meaningful connections.

TFCF believes that friendship lays the foundation for strong and lasting partnerships. Achieving the United Nations SDGs requires collaboration—nations and organizations must work together to overcome the complex challenges of international service projects.

By sharing interests, values, and goals, TFCF

has evolved from a traditional sponsorrecipient model to a partnership model, recognizing that no single entity possesses all the necessary resources, expertise, and influence to address the interconnected global challenges.

TFCF actively engages in two-way collaborative projects, including joint training, resource sharing, long-term mutual promotion, and community-led sustainable development. This approach emphasizes partnership and empowerment rather than simply providing one-way financial aid, creating a more sustainable and meaningful impact for communities worldwide.

TFCF partners with International NGOs (INGOs) worldwide to strengthen Taiwan's ties with the global community and provide children with a nurturing environment for growth. Cooperation between TFCF and WeWorld, a member of the ChildFund Alliance, began in 2023 during the Turkey-Syria earthquake. Since then, the two organizations have collaborated in rescue efforts, jointly protecting the most vulnerable children and families affected by crises.



In May, Ms. Stefania Piccinelli visited TFCF Headquarters in Taiwan to further strengthen the partnership. The visit provided an opportunity to exchange experiences, deepen mutual understanding, and explore future areas of collaboration to better serve global communities together.

TFCF works hand in hand with WeWorld to restore hope and confidence in more children and families. The partnership enables the pooling of resources, sharing technical expertise, and integration of diverse perspectives necessary to develop and implement effective solutions.

TFCF has been progressively aligning its programs with the UN's SDGs, particularly in child protection, education, and health. This shared focus on global objectives encourages partnerships with other organizations committed to building a better future.

Staying Together Makes Us Stronger

- Unity Is Strength

TFCF has been collaborating with Children Believe (CB) for nearly three decades, sponsoring children from vulnerable families overseas since 1995. The long-term collaboration experience has fostered a strong and enduring collaboration between the two organizations.

Since 2021, with the support of Taiwan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), TFCF and CB have jointly implemented a Preschool Child Development Program in India and Paraguay. In 2023, an Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) project was launched in Paraguay to promote the physical and mental development of children through schools, families, and communities, while strengthening emergent literacy among children aged 3 to 6.





SDG 4-2: Ensure that all children have access to quality early childhood development, care, and pre-primary education by 2030, so that they are ready for primary education.

The ECCD project in Paraguay supports children's growth from classrooms to families and communities. It has been implemented in two phases: Phase I in 2023, and Phase II from July 2024 to December 2025. The initiative is carried out through the partnerships of MOFA Taiwan, TFCF, and the CB Paraguay team, demonstrating how education can transform children's futures.



The project aims to strengthen emergent literacy and school readiness among children aged 0 to 4 in three marginalized communities, while contributing to the Government of Paraguay's commitment to SDG 4.2: ensuring that all girls and boys have access to quality early childhood development, care, and preprimary education.

Key activities of the ECCD project include organizing workshops, training teachers, providing bilingual (Spanish and Guarani) learning materials, and applying evidencebased practices for integrating play-based and literacy learning. In May 2024, practical workshops were conducted in three regions of Paraguay, targeting teachers and educators. These workshops addressed a variety of topics, including the developmental stages of children aged 0 to 4, Learning Through Play (LTP), positive parenting, and storytelling strategies and techniques.



Building Partnerships for a Sustainable Future

- Water Tank Construction and Community Education Support in Nepal





This partnership is especially meaningful because it goes beyond immediate aid and creates lasting, transformative change. By providing safe and reliable water while also supporting educational initiatives. TFCF and ViN are addressing both the physical and social needs of communities. Access to clean water reduces waterborne illnesses, improves hygiene, and ensures that children can attend school regularly.

The Water Tank Construction project is designed to ensure sustainable access to clean water. Each tank is built with community involvement, fostering ownership and long-term maintenance. Clean water not only reduces health risks but also alleviates the daily burden on families. This allows them more time for schoolwork, livelihoods, and personal growth.

At the same time, the Community Education Support project empowers young learners by providing school supplies, learning materials, and teacher training. The program emphasizes holistic child development, helping children gain



confidence, develop critical thinking skills, and nurture creativity.

Beyond these initiatives, TFCF collaborates with Right4children (R4C) on a Community Education Support project and with Kopila Nepal (KN) on an Empowering Future project. These partnerships aim to strengthen education, empowerment, and holistic development, supporting children, youth, and families to thrive despite economic and geographic challenges.

Through close collaboration with local NGOs, TFCF ensures that interventions are culturally relevant, community-driven, and sustainable. By combining access to clean water, education, and empowerment, TFCF is creating a blueprint for sustainable community transformation. Together with ViN and other partners, TFCF is helping remote Nepali communities build a brighter, healthier, and more hopeful future.
