

TFCF Kyrgyzstan: Opening ceremony of the new library

Reading brings many benefits to children, including improving reading skills, building character, expanding knowledge, and helping in informed decision-making. Encouraging children and families to discover their joy in reading, is one of TFCF's main focuses.

On March 11th, after days of renovations, TFCF Kyrgyzstan officially opened its new library. The branch office invited a publisher, an interpreter, a journalist, youths from capacity building program and other

community members to join the opening ceremony. On that day, the inspiring stories of Oprah Winfrey and Ingvar Kamprad were shared to motivate youths to continuously learn and uncover the truths of the world.

From now on, community members can come to TFCF's library to read and borrow books on variety topics. Though being opened not long ago, until the end of March, the library reached more than 100 people in the community.

TFCF Nutrition Improvement Programs

Nutrition and healthcare are essential for children's healthy development and wellbeing. Being given proper care and resource, children can thrive whilst unlocking their potentials. TFCF's nutrition improvement programs are designed to ensure children's overall wellbeing. The programs emphasize on the active involvement of parents by conducting parental trainings in nutrition for early childhood. In addition to provide local nutritious packages for children and families in needs, health-checks are also implemented to screen children with malnutrition for further indepth intervention. From January to March 2023, nutrition improvement programs brought impact to almost 700 children and careaivers.





TFCF Eswatini: Early Childhood Development Program

In the Kingdom of Eswatini, Early Childhood Development program focuses on early detection and treatment for children with developmental challenges. In this quarter, intensive occupational therapy and speech therapy were provided for 3 children. Our social workers work closely with the children's caregivers and the therapist to track the children's progress. Furthermore, 12 sessions on early childhood development, children's rights, positive discipline and child protection were conducted for community teachers to enhance their skills in working with children.



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
