

Vietnam | Nutrition Improvement Program Children's Development Can't Wait

UNICEF states that in 2022, there were nearly 7.8 million children under the age of 5 in Vietnam, but nearly 1.8 million of them suffer from stunting.

Since 2020, TFCF Vietnam has collaborated on a Nutrition Improvement Program with the Vietnam Association for Protection of Child Rights (VACR) to improve children's health and parenting knowledge in Ho Chi Minh City. Along with the impact, this program has been expanded and implemented in Hanoi in 2022.

TFCF, VACR, and the National Institute of Nutrition (NIN) together conducted essential health screenings for 401 children in Ba Vi District, Hanoi. The results revealed that a total of 91 examined children were malnourished. Therefore, TFCF Vietnam provided nutrition distribution to those malnourished children and organized parenting lectures for caregivers. However, TFCF is aware that not all children have the same opportunity to obtain additional resources for their development. TFCF Vietnam will continue to identify children in need and provide essential support to them.

Kyrgyzstan | Housing Support Program From a brick to a house

One in every three people in Kyrgyzstan lives below the poverty line. The primary sources of income for these poor families are agriculture, livestock, and temporary labor. Additionally, the current dilemmas are closely related to the lack of work opportunities and low wages.

Tarrant, Asser, and their three children are being sponsored by TFCF Kyrgyzstan. They lived in a very small and rudimentary house without a heating system. During the winter, temperatures can drop below freezing. To stay warm, they used to huddle together. Tarrant works as a temporary laborer with a low wage, which is all he can afford for his family.

After a home visit, a social worker discovered that this family was living in harsh conditions and needed assistance. TFCF provided them with building materials because Tarrant knew how to construct. Additionally, TFCF Kyrgyzstan invited an expert to assist in the rebuilding process to ensure structural safety. Eight months later, as the bricks were stacked up, the house had been transformed into a sturdy structure with a heating system. This family no longer has to endure cold temperatures during the winter and enjoys a more comfortable living environment.



Jordan | TFCF International Symposium

This September, TFCF Jordan organized an international symposium in Amman, Jordan with the theme 'Strengthening Actors **Synergies** Between Sustainable Development.' TFCF invited keynote speakers from various sectors, including the Ministry of Social Development of Jordan, Department of Education, UNDP, Mercy Corps, WeWorld, and the German Jordanian University, among others. The panel discussions focused on the importance of crossorganizational cooperation, education, and community development.

Mongolia | Tutoring Class Program

TFCF Mongolia implements a tutoring class program for sponsored children from economically disadvantaged families. Many parents work long hours and are unable to devote much attention to their children's education. Therefore, TFCF Mongolia collaborates with cram schools to offer students a better learning environment, educational activities, and meals. It's important to note that TFCF's goal is not only to enhance children's academic performance but also to help them build their confidence.
