

TFCF INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS



#### Mongolia | Clean Water Program

In response to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, and to help people access safe and affordable drinking water, TFCF Mongolia has been developing clean water program since 2007. These efforts have helped build water supply stations in nine districts of Ulaanbaatar and five rural towns, resulting in the construction of 30 water supply stations to date, seven of which are smart water supply stations. Additionally, since 2022, TFCF Mongolia has been promoting awareness campaigns to emphasize the importance of water usage and

sanitation. These efforts aim to enhance local residents' knowledge of water safety.

To facilitate the maintenance of the water supply stations, the Water Authority often prioritizes hiring local residents as managers. Therefore, building a new water supply station not only addresses the drinking water issues for nearby residents but also creates employment opportunities for women and enhances the economic capacity of families.

#### Kyrgyzstan | Women's Health and Sex Education

TFCF Kyrgyzstan and Red Crescent Society of Kyrgyzstan jointly organized an event on "Women's Health and Sex Education." The event aimed to guide teenage girls in exploring personal hygiene issues and promote the necessity of regular medical check-ups, encouraging them to seek professional help bravely. The activity also focused on enhancing local women's awareness of health education and sex education, which are often overlooked in developing countries. Social and cultural factors

often make many women too embarrassed to speak up or seek help or medical care. During the event, we emphasized the importance of personal boundaries in interpersonal relationships and self-respect, hoping that this knowledge would help teenage girls become healthier and stronger, and better able to defend themselves...

#### Jordan | Community Kitchen

This year, TFCF Jordan has continued to support the operation of community kitchens in Mafraq Province. With a community-centered, women-led, and empowerment-oriented approach, the initiative aims to improve the economic situation of women in the community.

One of the women working in the community kitchen, Aida, is a mother of five children. She has learned cooking and food processing skills and regularly fulfills orders at the community kitchen. In addition, she makes good use of these skills by using special equipment at home to produce spices, which she sells to her neighbors and markets through the community kitchen. With this income, Aida's family's financial burden has been greatly reduced, allowing her to provide a more stable and comfortable living environment for her children.





# Cambodia | Free Dental Clinic Project

In April, TFCF Cambodia, along with the local medical non-profit organization One-2-One, provided free dental services in the Andong community. The services included dental check-ups, pit and fissure sealants, extractions, and peripheral treatments. A total of 48 people benefited from the service, including 27 women. Before the treatment, doctors conducted detailed inquiries about patients' medical histories and physical conditions, and measured blood pressure to reduce the risk of treatment.

During the treatment, the doctors also provided brief health education information to enhance patients' awareness of dental health and proper dental hygiene practices.


