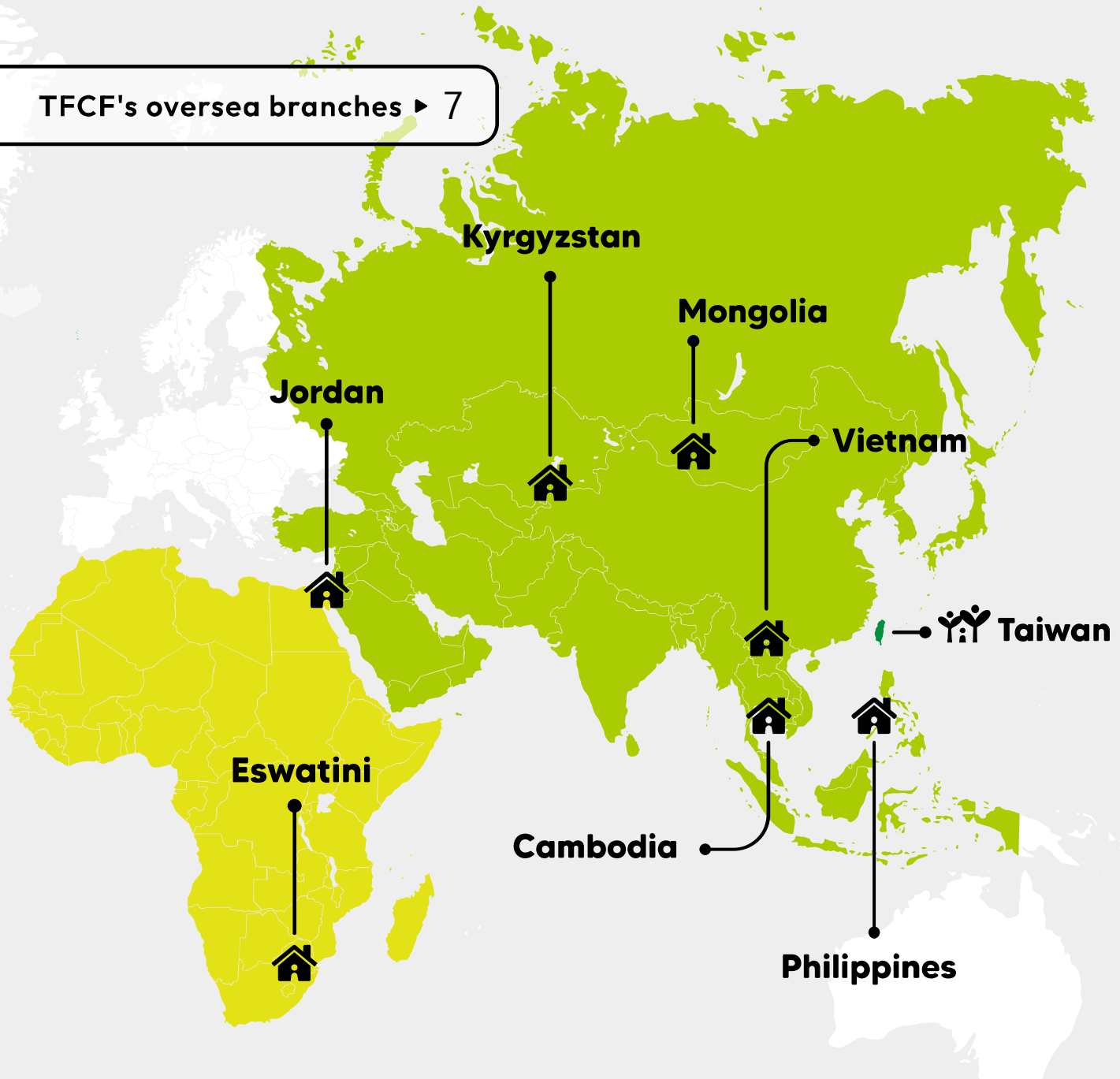

Jordan | ECD Program In The Talbieh Camp

Early Childhood Development (ECD) is crucial for both personal and societal progress. Research indicates that investing in ECD promotes social equity. When children from disadvantaged families receive adequate developmental opportunities, the cycle of poverty can be reduced. Consequently, governments and NGOs are increasingly prioritizing ECD as an integrated approach to facilitate children's development. TFCF Jordan has empowered community women to become teachers in early childhood

education, leading parenting groups and offering developmental courses while sharing essential knowledge. Community support is vital for the sustainability of ECD program. We look forward to ongoing collaboration with communities to extend our services to more families in need, fostering a healthier and happier next generation.

Philippines | Education Makes a Difference

COVID-19 has become a significant threat to children's education in the Philippines. While inequality in educational resources has existed for a long time, it has become even more pronounced since 2020. TFCF Philippines recognizes this problem and, in response, has started the After-School Tutoring Program to help children develop a passion for learning and engage with their school projects. Amila lives in a small room with six family members, making it difficult for him to study. He joined the after-school tutoring program, where a teacher

provides guidance. Initially, Amila felt frustrated with math and struggled to read in class. However, he didn't give up; he overcame his difficulties in math and even began helping others solve problems. Moreover, Amila gained confidence and learned how to collaborate and engage with his community. TFCF is devoted to create a better environment and opportunities for children to make a difference in their lives and futures.

Vietnam | Emergency Relief After a Disaster

Climate change has become an undeniable issue, causing suffering and losses worldwide due to abnormal weather. On September 7, Vietnam was devastated by Typhoon Yagi, particularly affecting crops and pig farms in the northern region. The service areas of TFCF Vietnam continue to face shortages of water, food and medicines, making it difficult for children to return to school. In response, TFCF Vietnam is providing substantial assistance to children and families through clean drinking water, products to control mosquito-borne diseases, nutritious food and beverages, first aid kits, and essential medicines, aiming to meet the needs of affected families.



Kenya | Found Hope in Water and Buckets

From October of last year to this year, Kenya has experienced severe flooding due to the El Niño phenomenon and climate change, posing significant threats to residents' lives and property. The flooding has led to issues such as disease outbreaks, drowning, lack of education, housing damage, and an increase in gender-based violence. In response, TFCF has partnered with International Rescue Committee (IRC) to implement a humanitarian relief project for flood-affected areas in Kenya. They provided non-food items (NFI) to all impacted families, including drinking water, buckets, hygiene and sanitation supplies, and dignity kits for women, benefiting a total of 200 households.

*Dignity kits: Specifically designed for women, these kits include essential hygiene products and clothing.
