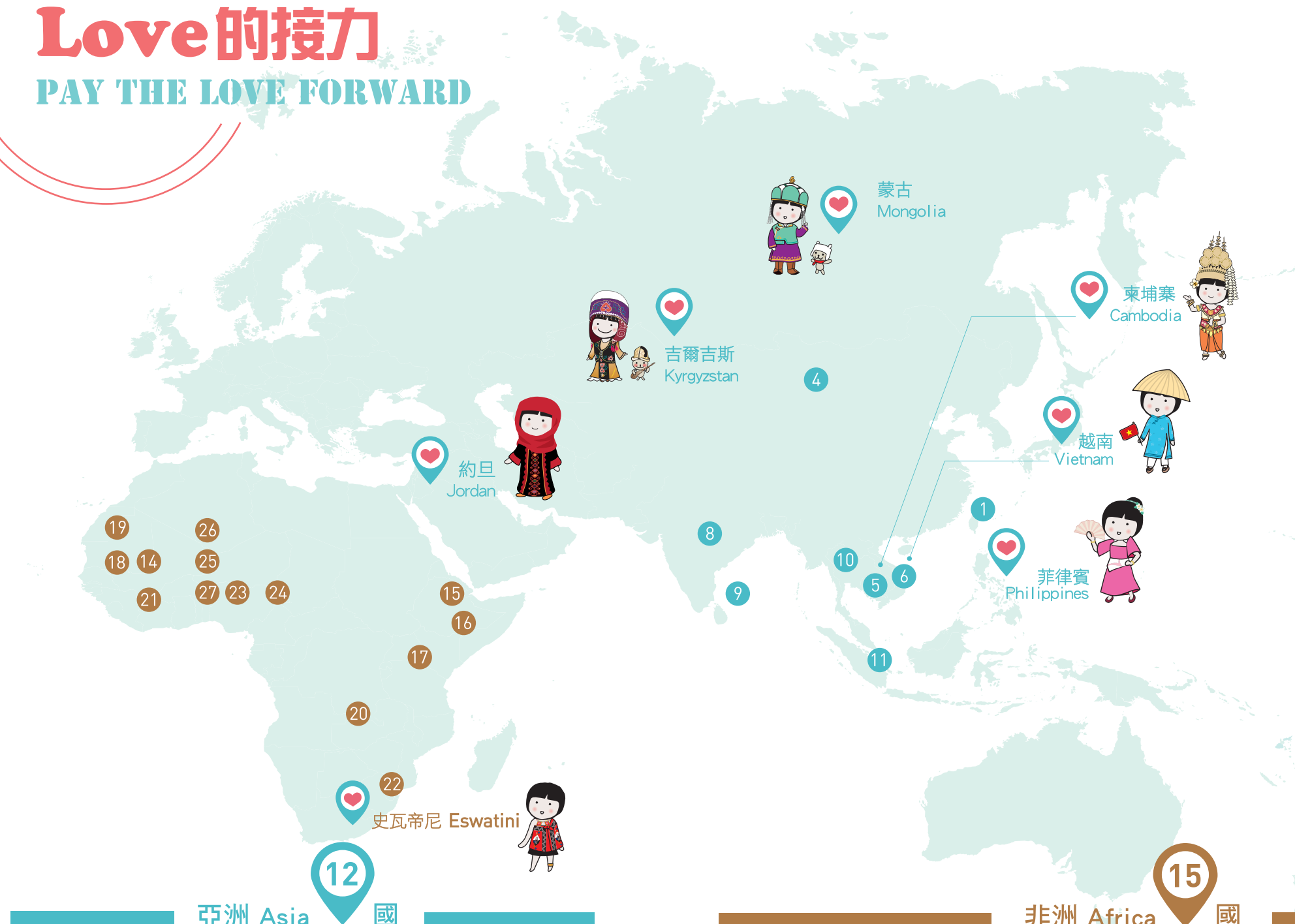

首先，要和大家分享一個好消息，2023 年家扶基金會以「國際兒童教育支持計畫」榮獲「TSAA 台灣永續行動獎 - 非企業組 SDG4 教育品質」特優獎，這是我們連續三年獲得 TSAA 台灣永續行動獎的肯定。

家扶基金會長期致力改善開發中國家兒童所面臨的不利處境，服務內容涵蓋貧窮、教育、醫療、社區等面向，其中教育無疑是最具意義和成效的社會投資之一，教育能夠幫助兒少培養技能和知識基礎，進而強化就業競爭力，提高生活品質並脫離貧窮。家扶能有如此成果，有賴全體家扶人和大眾的支持及努力，我身為董事長感到十分榮幸。

2023 年是史瓦帝尼家扶中心成立 10 週年，史瓦帝尼家扶中心為家扶第三個海外直接服務據點，現在扶助當地 47 個社區、約 6100 名孩子，提供「社區廚房」、「供水站」、「開心農場」等服務方案。中心在 7 月 14 日舉辦一場研討會，不僅回顧過去 10 年來豐碩的服務成果，也邀請在地機構共襄盛舉，齊力為史瓦帝尼的兒少權益與社區發展發聲。期許在下一個十年裡，史瓦帝尼家扶中心能持續發揮影響力，增進當地兒少、家庭及社區的福祉。

除此之外，2023 年更是早療服務的 30 周年，自 1992 年開始投入身心障礙兒童日間照顧與早療服務，每年服務約 4,000 位慢飛天使與其家庭，我們以家庭為中心、以社區為基礎，重視幼兒發展的權益、家庭參與之重要性以及社區資源互助協力。早療孩子需要有社會互動和學習融入社會生活的機會，呼籲社會大眾從自己做起，透過認識、理解、接納與尊重，並以友善的態度、行動和包容及支持性的措施，陪伴慢飛天使往前邁進。

在過去的一年裡，面對後疫情時代國內外經濟情勢之瞬息萬變，家扶基金會持續創新服務、精進社工專業。我要感謝每一位家扶的成員，秉持著「哪裡有需要，家扶就在那裡」的精神，在社會大眾支持下，服務深入台灣 368 個鄉鎮和海外 34 個國家，遍及每一個需要的角落。期待家扶基金會在新的一年，為社會帶來更多的溫暖和希望，讓愛與關懷繼續傳遞。

Support the Needy and Create the Future Together

Firstly, I am delighted to share an exciting news: TFCF "Foreign Children's Education Support Program" was bestowed the 2023 distinction award in the SDG4 "Quality Education" category at the TSAA hosted by Taiwan Institute for Sustainable Energy (TAISE). TFCF has been honored with the Taiwan Sustainable Action Awards (TSAA) for three consecutive years.

TFCF is committed to long-term efforts to improve the disadvantaged situations faced by children in developing countries. Our services encompass poverty alleviation, education, healthcare, and community development, with education recognized as one of the most impactful social investments. The education empowers children by cultivating skills and knowledge, enhances their competitiveness in the job market, improves their quality of life, and breaks the cycle of poverty. The collaborative efforts and support from our committed staff and the public have led to these achievements. As the chairman, I am deeply honored for the achievements of TFCF.

In 2023, we celebrated the 10th anniversary of the Eswatini TFCF Branch Office, the third overseas direct service location for TFCF. The office has expanded to 47 communities and approximately 6,100 children, providing services such as "Community Kitchen," "Water Station," and "Happy Farm." On July 14th, we hosted a seminar to assess our service outcomes over the past 10 years, and invited local organizations to join forces to champion the rights of children and promote community development in Eswatini. As we look ahead to the next decade, we aspire to see our Eswatini Branch Office continue making a lasting impact and fostering the well-being of local children, families, and communities.

2023 also marks the 30th anniversary of TFCF early intervention services. Since 1992, we have been providing day care and early intervention services for children with developmental delays, serving approximately 4,000 of these children and their families each year. We advocate for a family-centered, community-based approach that emphasizes the rights of child development, the importance of family involvement, and the collaboration of community resources. Children in early intervention programs need opportunities for social interaction and learning to integrate into community life. We call on the public to begin with themselves, adopting an attitude of understanding, acceptance, and respect, and through friendly and supportive measures and actions, to accompany these children as they move forward on their journey.

In the past year, facing the rapidly changing economic situations both domestically and internationally in the post-pandemic era, we continued to innovate services and enhance the professionalism of social work. I would like to express my gratitude to every member of TFCF who upholds the spirit of "Where there is a need, there is TFCF." With the support of the public, we extend our services to every corner in need, covering 368 townships in Taiwan and 34 countries worldwide. I look forward to TFCF bringing more warmth and hope to the society in the new year to keep paying love and care forward.

關懷奉獻 共攜成長

回顧 2023 年，家扶基金會經歷了許多挑戰，但同時也獲得無數的支持。在這一年中，面對疫情和經濟變動，本會始終堅守使命，秉持著關愛與奉獻的信念，穩定成長、堅定服務。我們感念所有支持者的無私奉獻，因著大家的愛心，今年受益的家庭及兒少人數分別為 6 萬 8589 戶和 10 萬 4955 人，您的支持不僅是我們克服困難的動力，也塑造了家扶基金會更堅強、更具韌性的未來。

今年我們將服務超過 30 年的館舍活化為「家扶教育館」，結合「兒保體驗館」及「家扶故事館」。「兒保體驗館」為全台首座以兒童保護為宗旨的互動體驗展館，期許讓每個孩子都能快樂安全成長，社會邁向「Kids First」、「Better Tomorrow」的美好願景。而故事館也呈現家扶自 1950 年以來的服務歷程及理念，藉此感念家扶因民眾的支持得以發展，期望號召更多人一同關懷弱勢兒少及家庭。

再者，本會為落實聯合國永續發展目標（SDGs）第 17 項「夥伴關係」，結合 ESG 永續及社會教育等概念，2023 年開辦 7 個社區行動計畫，鼓勵社區參與及行動，讓社區的自主性發揮影響力，為地方創造更多的價值及服務更多的社區民眾。

在國際服務部分，自疫情後，本會首次舉辦菲律賓認養人及認養童相見歡活動，透過家戶與社區的深度訪視，讓認養人實地瞭解家扶在當地所開展的社區減災與社區韌性方案，並持續支持本會在菲律賓深耕服務，改善菲國貧童的生活。此外，我們在約旦也舉辦「強化協作與永續發展」為主題之研討會，進行跨界、跨組織的合作，積極地與各領域的專業人士保持緊密而互惠的交流關係。我們相信，透過跨組織的合作，能更有效地迎戰困難，創造更具包容、發展的社會，讓更多資源注入，攜手共築世界兒童更美好的未來。

最後，我要特別感謝每一位員工的奉獻、每一位合作夥伴的支持，以及每一位認養人和捐款人的善心。您的參與和善舉不僅是組織的支柱，更是社區與社會進步的重要推動力，謝謝您！

Growing Together Through Mutual Care and Dedication

Reflecting on the year 2023, TFCF encountered various challenges but also received immense support. Throughout the year, in the face of the pandemic and economic fluctuations, our organization consistently adhered to its mission and upheld the belief of care and dedication to ensure stable growth and unwavering services. We extend heartfelt gratitude for the selfless contributions of all our supporters. With your love, we've been able to positively impact 68,589 families and 104,955 children this year. Your support not only propels us through challenges but also serves as the catalyst for shaping a more robust and resilient future for TFCF.

This year, we transformed a building that has been in service for over 30 years into the "TFCF Main Education Building," including the "Kids LOVE space" and the "TFCF Storyeum." The "Kids LOVE space" is the first interactive exhibition in Taiwan dedicated to child protection, aiming to ensure that every child can grow up happily and safely. We hope to lead the society toward where "Kids First" and a "Better Tomorrow" are prioritized. And, through the TFCF Storyeum, we showcase our service history and philosophy since 1950 and express our heartfelt gratitude for the public support that has propelled our development. We hope to encourage greater participation in caring for vulnerable children and their families.

Furthermore, to fulfill the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 17 on "Partnerships," in conjunction with SDGs, ESG sustainability, and social education concepts, we launched seven community action projects to encourage community participation and engagement. These projects enable the autonomy of communities to exert its influence to create more values locally and serve a greater number of community members.

In the international service sector, we hosted the first sponsors and sponsored children's reunion event in the Philippines since the outbreak of the pandemic. Through in-depth visits to households and communities, sponsors were able to gain firsthand insight into our local community disaster reduction program and community resilience program. This experience encouraged sponsors to continuously support TFCF's ongoing efforts in the Philippines, working towards improving the lives of impoverished Filipino children. Additionally, we organized a seminar in Jordan with the theme "Strengthen Synergies Between Actors For Sustainable Development" fostering cross-sector and cross-organizational cooperation. We actively engaged in mutually beneficial exchanges with professionals from various fields. We hold the belief that effective collaboration among organizations is vital for addressing challenges, fostering inclusivity and development, and combining resources to collectively shape a brighter future for children worldwide.

Lastly, I would like to express special thanks for the dedication of every staff member, the support of every partner, and the generosity of every sponsor and donor. Your involvement and kindness are not only pillars of the organization but also crucial driving forces for community and societal progress. Thank you!

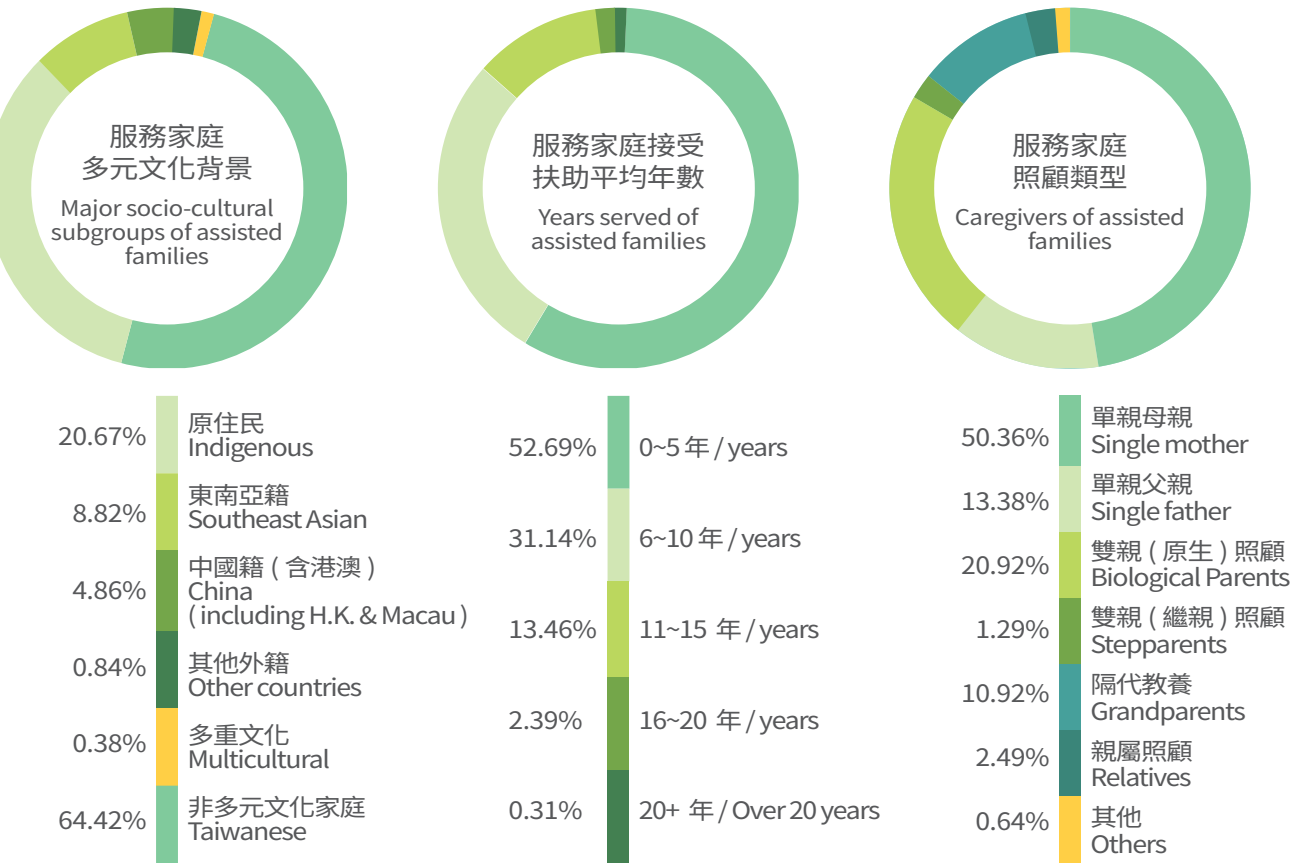


貧困兒童少年家庭扶助服務

Assistance for Needy Children, Youth and Their Families

家庭扶助服務從認養費補助、實物發放，逐步發展出多元的服務方案，並與時俱進地融入 CRC 及 SDGs 的原則及目標，使兒少及其家庭在基本生活獲得穩定外，也能擁有更多的參與機會、獲得多元的資源，邁向脫貧自立的未來，進而參與社會及連結，最終帶動社會共好的良善循環。

Support services for needy Families have developed in response to the societal demands. In addition to providing sponsorship subsidies and in-kind assistance, diverse service programs have gradually been established to address the need of children, youth and families. These programs integrated with the principles and goals of the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to ensure that children, youth and their families not only attain stability in their basic living conditions but also gain more opportunities for participation and access to diverse resources. This paves the way for a future of poverty alleviation and self-reliance, enabling them to actively engage in society, establish connections, and ultimately contribute to the virtuous cycle of societal well-being.



穩定生活

Livelihood Support

家庭扶助

為照顧貧困兒少及其家庭，滿足其生活基本需求，以家庭為中心的「家庭認養」制度，提供兒少及其家庭生活、學習發展所需資源，使其獲得更完整、穩定的協助。2023 年共計幫助 25,408 戶家庭、家庭中 57,221 名兒少，其中以認養制度扶助 43,104 名兒少。

健康維持服務

為重視兒少的營養補充與均衡，社工於個案、家庭工作過程中，適時連結各項營養資源，隨著時代變遷、飲食習慣的改變，兒少營養品日趨多元化，自 2018 年起將實物供給改為現金補助，以更具彈性的方式補充兒少營養需求。2023 年提供 2,309 份家庭認養用於健康維持，共計 1,215 戶家庭、1,589 位兒少受益。

急難救助

針對遭逢變故，導致生活陷於困境的家庭，提供最適切與即時的幫助。對弱勢家庭而言，若家庭本身資源不足，抵禦風險衝擊的能力相當有限，本會也進一步提供重大醫療、災害等急難協助，以穩定其生活。另，為提升家庭風險預防能力，也提供家庭火災緊急避難包，積極進行重大災害事前預備工作。2023 年共計提供 13,267 戶次急難救助服務。

Family Sponsorship Program

In order to take care of disadvantaged children, youth and families and ensure each household meets its basic needs, TFCF has launched Family Sponsorship Program to provide the resources of living and learning support which improve their lives with stable assistance for each household. In 2023, a total of 25,408 households and 57,221 children and youth were assisted, with 43,104 children and youth enrolled in the Family Sponsorship Program.

Nutrition Program

To emphasize the importance of nutrition supplementation and balance for children, social workers timely connect families with various nutrition resources during individual and family work. Along with time and dietary habits changing, the diversity of nutritional products for children is increasing. Since 2018, in-kind supplies have been replaced with cash subsidies to supplement children's nutritional needs more flexibly. In 2023, 2,309 family sponsorships were designated under the Nutrition Program, benefiting 1,215 households and 1,589 children.

Emergency Relief

For families facing adversity that has plunged them into hardship, we offer the most appropriate and immediate assistance. Vulnerable families often have limited resources to withstand the impacts of risks. Therefore, we provide emergency relief in the event of major medical crisis or disasters to stabilize their lives. Furthermore, to enhance the preventive capabilities of families against risks, we also provide evacuation emergency kit for home fires and actively engage in preparations for major disasters. In 2023, a total of 13,267 households/times were provided with Emergency Relief Services.



家庭支持性服務

隨著社會環境改變，家庭需求多元，本會辦理各項家庭支持性服務，協助家庭運用社區資源，增進家庭親子正向互動關係、豐富兒少成長經驗。2023 年辦理團體輔導 934 次、16,793 人次參與；營隊 / 體驗活動 84 場次、4,032 人次參與；家庭活動 365 場次、32,723 人次參與；兒童關懷夥伴服務 1,308 人次。

自立家庭追蹤關懷服務

秉持「陪伴走向自立安穩路」的服務理念，期能減緩扶助家庭面臨全戶停止扶助後對家庭之衝擊，為使扶助家庭自立過程更平順，提供為期一年的追蹤關懷服務，適時提供資源，以協助家庭突發事件的因應，增加自立家庭生活穩定。2023 年共計追蹤 1,085 戶、結束追蹤 699 戶。

居家生活環境改善計畫

聯合國的 17 項永續發展核心目標（SDGs）「健康與福祉、淨水與衛生」是本會扶助方案中著重的議題與需求，我們時常在服務過程中看見家庭居住於環境髒亂、狹小的空間，或家庭沒有自來水而使用不乾淨的水源，更有家庭沒有安裝熱水器，是家庭冬天洗澡時的一大難題。

為了改善家庭的居住安全與生活品質，本會自 2022 年開始設置居家生活環境改善計畫，提供家庭居家環境修繕、生活必要設備、家電添購之經費補助，協助其提升其居住安全與生活品質，更達到永續發展目標。2023 年提供 331 戶此計畫補助。

Family Supporting Program

As the social environment changes and family needs become more diverse, we provide various family support services to help households to utilize the community resources, enhance positive parent-child interaction and enrich childhood experience. In 2023, we organized 934 group counseling sessions with 16,793 attendances; 84 camps/experience activities with 4,032 attendances; 365 family activities with 32,723 attendances; child care partner services with 1,308 attendances.

Self-Reliant Family Follow-Up Service

Adhering to our service concept "accompanying children towards self-reliant", we provide a one-year Self-Reliant Family Follow-Up Program. We aim to alleviate the initial impact on families who no longer receive our financial assistance upon achieving self-reliance by providing them with timely resources in responding to unforeseen events, thus enhancing the stability of the families. In 2023, the program monitored a total of 1,085 households, and 699 households successfully closed their cases.

Living Environment Improvement Program

The United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly "Good Health and Well-being" and "Clean Water and Sanitation," are focal points and essential needs emphasized in our assistance programs. In our service processes, we often encounter families living in dirty and cramped environments, lacking access to clean water sources, or facing challenges bathing in winter due to the absence of water heaters.

To improve the safety and quality of life for these families, TFCF has initiated a Living Environment Improvement Program since 2022. This program provides subsidies for home repairs, essential household equipment, and household appliances, aiming not only to enhance the safety and quality of life but also to achieve sustainable development goals. In 2023, this program provided assistance to 331 households.



教育提升 Education

學習資源協助計畫

此計畫透過教育與學習資源的補充，提供所需之用品、安親 / 補習費、療育費、數位載具等補助，期待穩定扶助兒少的學習需求與發展。2023 年學習資源協助共計 62,436 人次，以國小階段占 67% 為最高、其次為國中 23%、高中 9%、幼稚園 6%；而疫情過後數位載具已成為趨勢，最需要使用此資源的對象則為大專生為主，故本年度開放大專生申請數位載具補助，提供 94 人次的大專生此計畫補助。

獎助學金

為鼓勵及肯定兒少在學業上勤奮努力，並減輕家庭龐大經濟負擔，2023 年提供兒少求學路上各階段獎助學金，共計頒發 45,405 人次，穩定兒少持續學習的力量。

菁英培植方案補助及追蹤計畫

小睿透過菁英培植的出國補助，到泰國參加極限廚師挑戰賽之亞洲咖哩挑戰賽（青年組），並榮獲銀牌，這次可以與其它選手交流的機會實在難得，小睿說：「感謝幫助我的每一個人，這些經歷都將成為我餐飲路上的養分，將來我也會將所學到的知識與技術傳授給後來的莘莘矚子。」

為增加兒少有更多元發展的可能性，提升未來升學或就業的競爭力與自信心，2023 年共補助 1,226 人次，其考試 / 檢定通過率以證照考試占 67.2% 為最高，其次為公職考試 36.8%、語言檢定 29.9%、才藝競賽檢定 24.3%、升學考試 16.1%。

課業輔導方案

方案設計以「自主行動、溝通互動、社會參與」三個面向為主，除了學科學習表現外，更重視兒少在課外、日常生活的學習體驗，透過「主題式課程」，期待累積兒少正向學習經驗、提升學習動機，並使其在學習之路上逐漸發芽、茁壯。

才藝培育方案

本會全國共有 22 個中心、67 支才藝隊，類型包括舞蹈、音樂、打擊樂、運動、美術、傳統藝術等，2023 年服務 997 位兒少、提供 7,953 小時課程，透過才藝培育，提供兒少多元學習機會，提升自我價值，增強自信，亦從中發掘有特殊專長潛力的兒少。



Study Resources

Through the supplementation of educational and learning resources, this program provides necessary learning materials, childcare/tutoring fees, early intervention expenses, digital devices, etc., aiming to support the learning needs and development of children. In 2023, a total of 62,436 individuals received assistance for learning resources, with primary school students accounting for the highest proportion at 67%, followed by junior high school students at 23%, high school students at 9%, and kindergarten students at 6%. Following the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, digital devices have become a trend to use for education, with college students having the major resource demand. Therefore, this year, the program opened applications for digital device subsidies to college students, providing the assistance to 94 college students.

Scholarship and Student Aids

To motivate and encourage children and youth to study hard, we provided various scholarship and grants for children and youth to reduce the huge financial burden of families. The cumulative total of approved scholarship applications in 2023 was 45,405 which helped stabilize children's learning status.

Elite Program and Follow-up Plan

To encourage diversified development for children and youth from disadvantaged families and enhance their competitiveness and self-confidence for future academic pursuit or employment opportunities, we provided subsidies for examinations to 1,226 applications in 2023. Among the recipients, those who took certification exams achieved the highest pass rate of 67.2% , followed by 36.8% for civil service exams, 29.9% for language proficiency tests, 24.3% for talent competition certifications, and 16.1% for school entrance exams.

After-school Tutoring Program

The program design revolves around three main aspects: "autonomous action, communication and interaction, and social participation." In addition to academic performance, it places greater emphasis on children's learning experiences beyond the curriculum and in daily life. Through "thematic courses," we hope to accumulate positive learning experiences for children, enhance their motivation to learn, and foster their growth along their way of learning.

Talent Cultivatio Program

The program is offered in 22 of our branch offices with a total of 67 TFCF Children Talent Teams being organized, featuring dance, music, percussion, sports, art, traditional arts, and more. In 2023, we served 997 children and youth and provided 7,953 hours of courses. Through the program, we offered diverse learning opportunities to enhance their self-worth and self-confidence, as well as to identify children and youth with potential.



脫貧能力建構方案

Capacity Building for Anti-Poverty

本會依不同年齡層的發展需求，推展個別之能力建構服務方案，並致力於發展性社會工作服務，協助家庭開發就業機會與相關職能培訓，使扶助家庭達到積極脫貧的目的。

兒童啟力計畫

計畫以兩年一期循環，第一年以啟蒙方案幫助學齡前幼兒就學，提升幼兒發展、家長教養能力及建立正向親子互動；第二年增加理財教育，協助家長累積兒童教育基金。2023 年為幼兒啟蒙方案，有 179 戶家庭完成方案課程，其中有超過 9 成家長認為此方案對於親職育兒、親子關係、生活支持及兒童學習發展上有幫助。

少年展力計畫

創造一個專屬青少年的平台，透過方案活動與課程持續累積其正向經驗與回憶；2023 年辦理 558 場服務活動、共有 10,100 人次參加。透過鼓勵、引導青少年從「做中學」過程中，發展少年所需要的洞察力、自信力、規劃力、生活力、團隊力和關懷力等六項能力。

青年構力計畫

「青年自立釣竿方案」本屆有 209 名青年完成方案，以「社會關懷與人權」、「愛與尊重」、「在地文化」、「科技與環境安全」四大主軸 20 個議題，透過引導青年對社會現象的關心與敏感度，進一步投入之社會服務及青年發聲行動。

「青年就業準備服務」提供青年自立前後，能有更好的預備來面對新生活的挑戰。2023 年有 52 人完成此項計畫申請，提供其就業所需之學習、生活費用、技能培養等。

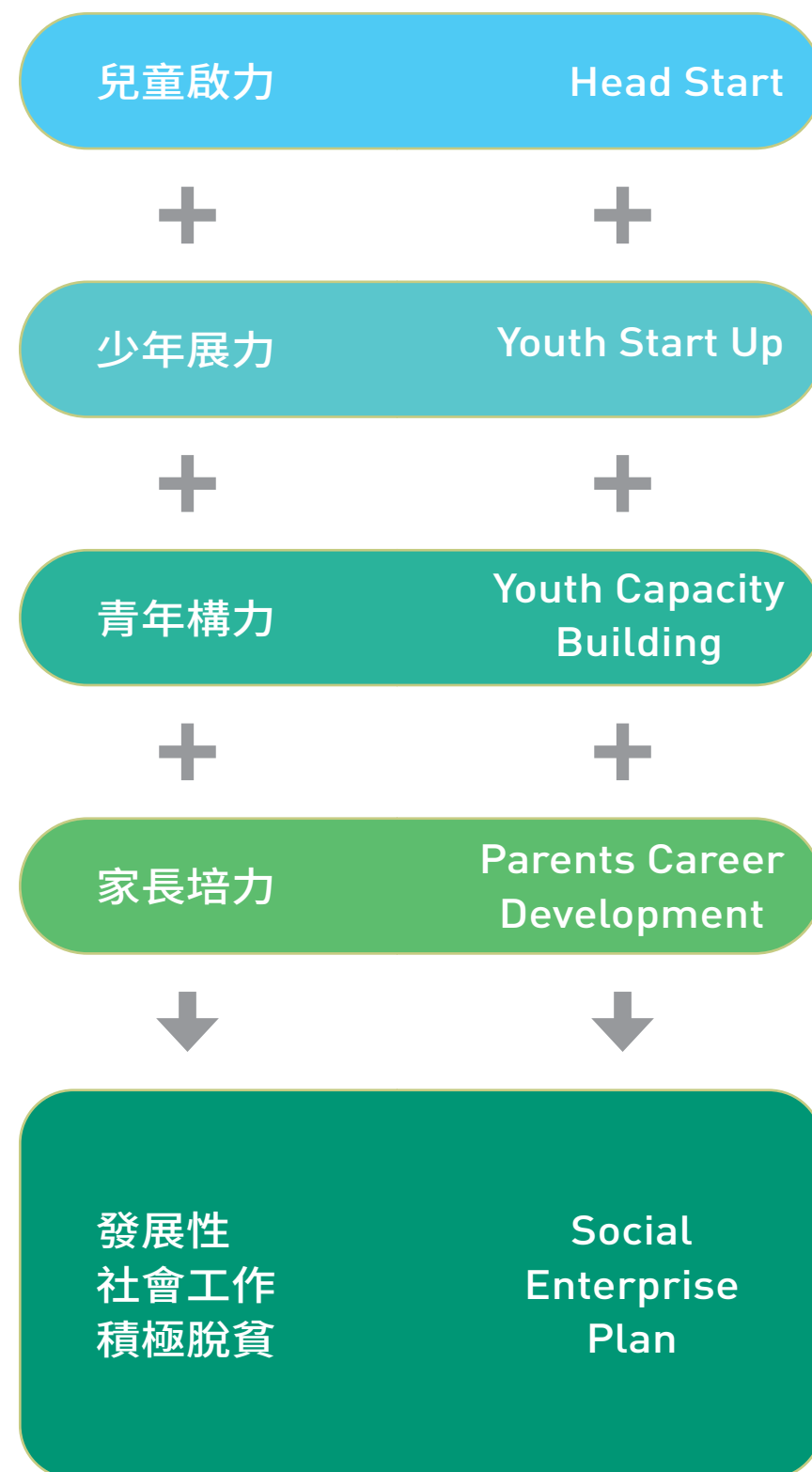
家長培力計畫

2023 持續「財務力」的培力，透過財務知能相關課程的安排，培養家長理財和理債的基本知能，且今年也進行「專業力」的培力，因家長學習領域的多元，多採取網絡合作方式，媒合訓練單位協助家長進行第二專長的學習，爭取求職成功的機會。2023 年共計有 110 位家長完成方案課程。

社會企業計畫

目前有苗栗、南台中、宜蘭、花蓮、澎湖等 5 個中心推展幸福小舖方案，服務 50 名家長和青年。幸福小舖持續針對成員專業力和經營力進行培力，服務設計包含：系統性的學習課程規劃、成員個別專長的精進、鼓勵成員參與討論和決策等，除了前述能力的培養外，亦規劃跨單位的交流，鼓勵成員分享所學，同時也會進行社會服務的活動，鼓勵成員有機會貢獻所學來關懷其他弱勢族群。



According to the developmental needs across different age groups, our organization promotes individualized capacity-building service plans. We are committed to the developmental social work services, assisting families in developing employment opportunities and relevant vocational training. The effort aims to help assisted families break free from poverty.

Head Start Program

The Head Start Program is designed to operate on a two-year cycle. The enlightenment program is implemented in the first year to help pre-school children attend school, improve their development, and establish positive parent-child interaction through parenting skills building. The parents' financial management course is added in the second year to guide parents in accumulating education funds for their children. In 2023, the focus was on the enlightenment program and 179 households completed the program curriculum. Among them, over 90% of parents believed that this program was helpful for parenting, parent-child relationships, life supports and children's learning and development.

Youth Start Up Program

We create an exclusive platform for adolescents to continuously accumulate positive experiences and memories through program activities and courses. In 2023, 558 service activities were held with a total of 10,100 participants. Through encouraging and guiding adolescents in the process of "learning by doing", they developed the six skills they need, including insight, self-confidence, planning, vitality, teamwork and caring.

Youth Capacity Building Program

There were 209 college students who completed TFCF Fishing Pole Program this year. With four main themes - "Social Care and Human Rights," "Love and Respect," "Local Culture," and "Technology and Environmental Safety" - and 20 focus issues, the program aims to guide youth in developing their awareness and sensitivity to social phenomena, further engaging them in social services and youth advocacy actions.

The "Youth Employment Preparation Service" aims to better prepare youths to face the challenges of new life before and after self-reliance. In 2023, 52 of them completed applications for this program, receiving support for their employment preparations, including learning, living expenses, and skill development.

Parents Career Development Program

In 2023, there was continued emphasis on enhancing "financial capability" by arranging courses related to financial literacy to develop basic skills in financial management and debt management for parents. Additionally, efforts were made to enhance "professional capability" this year. Due to the diverse learning interests of parents, a collaborative approach through networking was adopted to match training units and assist parents in acquiring secondary expertise to increase their chances of successful employment. In 2023, a total of 110 parents completed the program courses.

Social Enterprise Plan: TFCF Xingfu Shop

There are 5 branch offices promoting TFCF Xingfu Shop program in Miaoli, Southern Taichung City, Yilan, Hualien and Penghu, serving 50 parents and youth. We continued to provide professional and operational capabilities training for them. The service design includes systematic learning course planning, individual skill enhancement for members, and encouragement for member participation in discussions and decision-making. In addition to cultivating these abilities, cross-unit exchanges are planned to encourage members to share what they have learned. Moreover, social service activities are organized to provide members with opportunities to contribute their knowledge and care for other vulnerable groups.

兒童少年保護服務

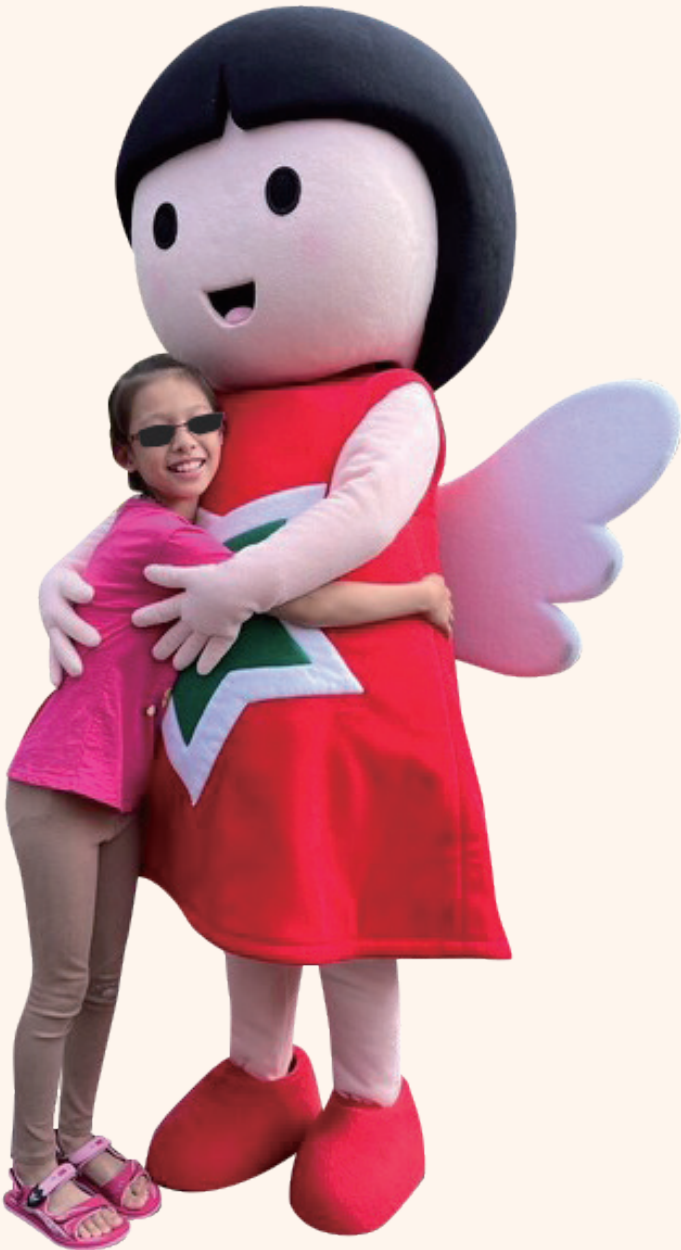
Child Protection Service

兒少是國家發展的重要人力資源，提供兒少安全的生活環境，確保其健康成長，不僅是每一個家庭的責任，也是國家與社會責無旁貸的工作。本會自 1987 年起推展兒童少年保護服務工作，並積極投入救援 / 輔導服務，防止不當對待事件再次發生，以及減輕兒童少年及其家庭因不當對待事件所導致之負面影響。

2023 年度共深入輔導協助 2,869 戶 4,390 名兒童及少年，這些在社會角落暗中哭泣的兒少，不僅需要政府持續的正視、社福機構的專業服務，更需要社會大眾共同關懷與守護，協助他們走出傷痛與陰霾。

Children and youth are vital human resources for national development. Providing them with a safe living environment and ensuring their healthy growth is not only the responsibility of every family, but also an undeniable responsibility for the government and society. Since 1987, our organization has been promoting child and youth protection services, actively engaging in rescue/ counseling services to prevent incidents of mistreatment from recurring and to mitigate the negative impacts on abused children, youth, and their families.

In 2023, we provided in-depth counseling and assistance to 2,869 households and 4,390 children and youth. These children and youth, who silently suffer on the margins of society, not only require continuous attention from the government and professional services from social welfare organizations but also need the collective care and protection of society to help them overcome their pain and darkness.

家庭處遇計畫

以家庭為基礎，提供有計畫性的相關服務，以增強兒少復原力、父母或主要照顧者親職能力、改善及提昇家庭功能，進而提供兒少完善照顧與安全的生活環境。2023 共提供 2,869 戶、3,184 名遭受不當對待兒少及其 1,206 名手足此項服務，且 85% 以上的家庭皆能在接受服務 1.5 年內有正向的改變。

生活照顧

對於因經濟困難而疏於提供兒童少年完善的生活與身體照顧的家庭，本會運用社會資源與志工人力，給予經濟或實物補助、家務整理、居家環境改善、重整生活規範與秩序、托育服務、兒少活動、家庭或機構式安置服務等。

醫療協助

當兒少因不當對待事件造成身體傷害而需要醫療時，家扶提供即時的醫療照顧與協助；若施虐者、受到不當對待兒少之主要照顧者有酒癮、藥癮或是精神疾患困擾，亦會協助連結或轉介至醫療單位，提供進一步的戒治協助。

親職教育

2023 年共有 6 處家扶中心提供 559 位兒童少年保護個案家長的親職教育輔導服務，並辦理 593 場次 2373 人次親職與親子團體 / 講座 / 活動，協助家長學習正確的親職教養觀念，提升其照顧與保護子女的實質知能。

諮詢及法律服務

2023 年提供 5,000 人次以上電話、面談、書面、網路等諮詢服務，協助社會大眾解答有關兒少保護事件的疑問，提供相關知識、資訊與社會資源；若涉及法律訴訟問題，則轉介法律專業人員予以協助。

預防宣導教育服務

2023 年持續運用網路、廣播社群平台，以及影音、線上遊戲和實體互動宣導等不同管道，發展更多的宣導教材和倡議內容，共辦理 485 場次宣導活動，針對全國至少有 146,966 人次的兒少、家長、相關專業人員以及社會大眾，宣導正確保護兒少的觀念與知識，共同維護兒少的安全與權益。

會本部亦將舊有辦公空間規劃為「兒保體驗館」（Kids LOVE space），成為全國第一個以兒童保護三級預防為主題、運用原創開發的科技多媒體素材做為兒保互動學習的體驗館場。

Family Intervention

According to the needs of families, we provide the planned services to enhance the resilience of maltreated child/youth and the parental ability of parents or key caregivers, and also improve family functioning to offer a safe and secure living environment for children and youth with comprehensive care. In 2023, a total of 2,869 households, 3,184 mistreated child/youth and 1,206 siblings received this service, and more than 85% of the families had positive changes within 1.5 years after being served.

Livelihood Support

For families who are unable to provide adequate care and support for children and youth due to economic difficulties, our organization utilizes social resources and volunteers to provide economic or in-kind assistance, household chores assistance, home environment improvement, restructuring of life norms and order, childcare services, activities for children and youth, as well as family or institutional placement services.

Medical Care Assistance

TFCF provides timely medical care assistance while children and youth need medical treatment due to physical abuse. If the abuser or the primary caregiver of the abused child has alcohol and drug addiction or mental illness, we would also help contact or refer to medical units for further assistance.

Parenting Education

In 2023, a total of 6 our branch offices provided parental education and counseling services to 559 parents who involved in child protection cases. They also organized 593 sessions attended by 2,373 individuals, including parent-child groups, seminars, and activities, aiming to assist parents in acquiring correct parenting concepts and enhancing their practical skills in caring for and protecting their children.

Consulting Legal Services

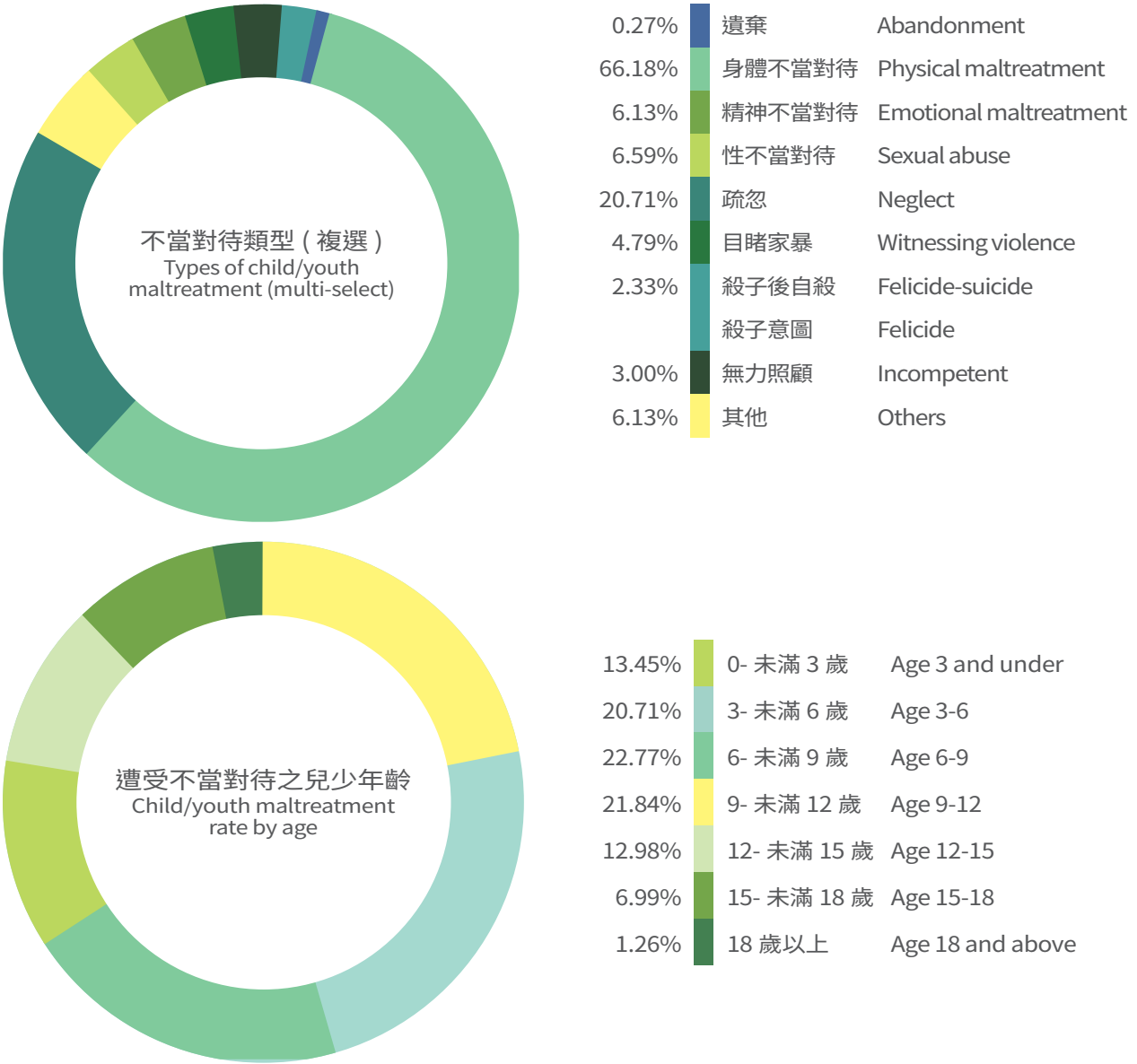
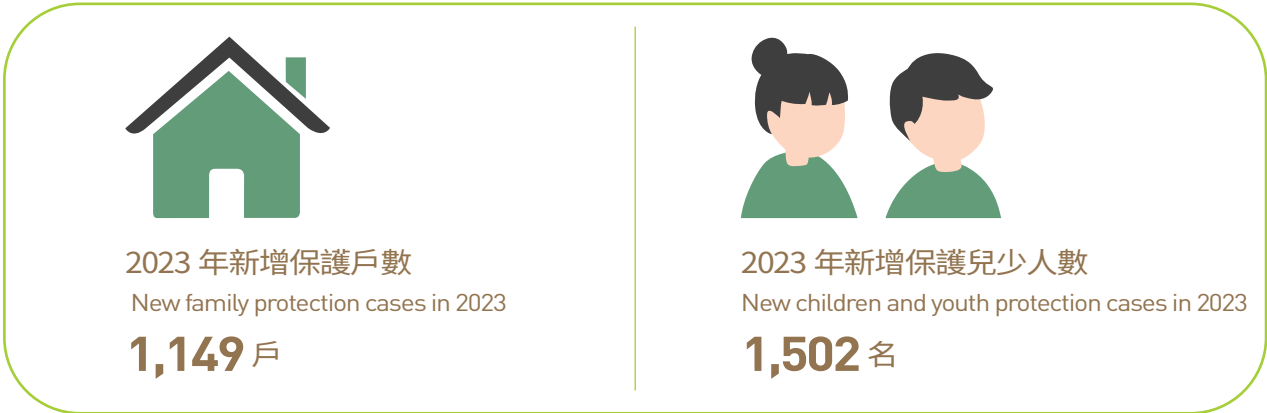
In 2023, we provided more than 5,000 consultation responses through phone calls, interviews, written reports, internet interactions, etc. to answer questions to the public about the protection of children and youth and provide relevant knowledge, information and social resources. If other legal litigation issues were involved, they would be referred to legal professionals for assistance.

Child/Youth Protection Advocacy Services

In 2023, we continued to utilize various channels such as the internet, broadcasting, social media platforms, as well as audiovisual media, online games, and physical interactions to develop more advocacy materials and promotional content. A total of 485 advocacy events were held, targeting at least 146,966 children, youth, parents, relevant professionals, and the general public nationwide. The aim was to promote the correct concepts and knowledge of protecting children, jointly safeguarding their safety and rights.

The headquarters also transformed its existing office space into the "Kids LOVE Space", becoming the country's first interactive learning space focused on child protection at all three levels of prevention. We utilize original and developed technology multimedia materials as the main theme for child protection interaction learning in the experience space.

Analysis of new child protection cases in 2023



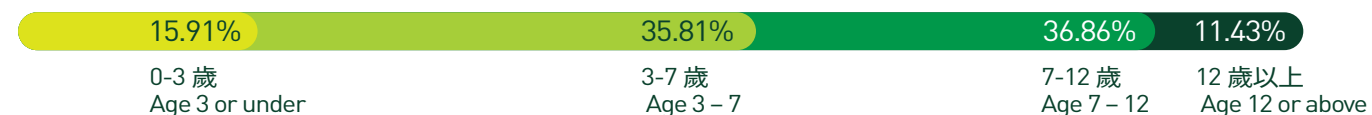

寄養安置服務

Foster Care Service

寄養安置服務是兒少福利中替代性服務之一，當父母罹患重病、入獄，或照顧者不適任親職等因素時，透過政府公權力介入並由專業社工評估後，安排適合的寄養家庭，為兒少提供一個有計畫期間的替代性照顧 - 溫馨的避風港，讓兒少得以健康快樂長大，早日重返正常生活。

Foster Care Service is one of the alternative services in child/youth welfare. When parents suffer from serious illnesses, are incarcerated, or are deemed unfit to care for their children, the government intervenes through its public authority and arranges suitable foster families after professional social work assessments. This provides children with a planned period of alternative care. We offer care and companionship which help children grow up healthy and happy and return to normal life as soon as possible.

親屬安置服務

Kinship Care Service

親屬安置是一種家庭式的替代性服務，當兒少原生家庭發生重大變故，沒有辦法再照顧養育、或兒少不適合繼續住在原生家庭裡時，經由政府單位進行專業評估後，優先考量將兒少安置在適當的親屬家庭裡接受照顧、養育及保護。

Kinship Care is a family-style alternative service. When a major incident occurs in a child's original family, and they are no longer able to provide care or if it is deemed inappropriate for the child to continue living with them, the government conducts a professional assessment and gives priority to placing the child with appropriate relatives for care, nurturing, and protection.

- Regularly evaluate the counseling situation of foster children and strengthen long-term counseling plans for foster children who cannot return home due to the loss of family function.

機構安置輔導服務

Institutional Placement Service

機構安置服務是兒少保護服務的第三道防線，當兒少遭受不當對待、疏忽、或違反法律時需要接受保護安置的替代性福利服務。本會分別依收容對象、功能及服務內容之差異設立不同類型的兒童及少年安置及教養機構。

Foster care placement service is one of the alternative services in child/youth welfare. When parents suffer from serious illnesses, are incarcerated, or are deemed unfit to care for their children, the government intervenes through its public authority and arranges suitable foster families after professional social work assessments. This provides children with a planned period of alternative care. We offer care and companionship which help children grow up healthy and happy and return to normal life as soon as possible.

Placement Service for Maltreated Child and Youth

In 2023, a total of 74 abused child/youth were placed. According to their characteristics and needs, we provided accommodation, life counseling and education, medical care, psychological counseling and treatment, school & employment counseling, family restoration counseling, recreational activities, and other services.

不幸少女安置服務 (含緊急短期安置)

近年來，社會急速變遷，使得家庭照顧功能受到極大的挑戰，再加上科技與媒體迅速發展與傳播，易引發兒少偏差行為，嚴重影響其身心發展。

兒少遭性剝削的影響是多元且複雜的，安置對象通常是經由社政主管機關或警察機關查獲從事性剝削，或疑似遭受性剝削之虞的少女。

2023 年協助 7 位不幸少女緊急或長期安置服務，提供住宿服務與安全保護、生活輔導與教育、醫療服務與衛教輔導、家庭關係重建與輔導、心理輔導與治療等服務內容，期能幫助她們療傷止痛，重建其對未來生命的希望。

Emergent Placement Service for Needy Teenager Girls (including Emergency Short-Term Placement)

In recent years, rapid social changes have posed significant challenges to the functionality of family care. In addition, the rapid development and dissemination of technology and media can easily lead to deviant behavior in children and youth, severely affecting their physical and mental development.

The impact of sexual exploitation on children and youth is diverse and complex. Typically, placement targets are girls who have been detected by social welfare agencies or police agencies engaging in sexual exploitation or are suspected of being at risk of sexual exploitation.

In 2023, we assisted 7 miserable teenager girls with emergency or long-term placement services. TFCF provided the service including accommodation and security protection, general counseling and education, medical services and health education counseling, family restoration counseling, psychological counseling, mental trauma counseling and treatment, etc. Our goal was to help them heal and rebuild their hope for their future lives.

曝險少年司法轉向安置輔導服務

2023 年提供 23 名曝險少年安置服務，其中新安置少年有 9 名；接受安置之少年均為地方法院為保護處分須交付安置輔導之 18 歲以下兒童少年。

其到安置機構接受輔導的最主要目的是希望藉由環境的變換，讓少年能脫離原來誘使其犯罪的相關事物等情境，再藉由改變少年的生活習慣，建立一套比較有秩序的生活模式，使少年有一正常生活作息之後，再慢慢影響少年的品德與價值觀。

Placement Service for Risk Exposure Teenagers Referred by the Court

In 2023, we provided placement services to 23 risk exposure teenagers, of which 9 were newly placed. These teenagers were all under 18 years old and were placed under the protection order of the local court.

The main purpose to place them into placement institutes for counseling is to provide a change in environment, allowing them to separate from the situations and factors that led to their delinquent behavior. Through changes in their daily habits and routines, we aim to establish a more orderly and structured lifestyle, allowing the teenagers to gradually develop positive moral values and perspectives on life. Our ultimate goal is to offer a normal and stable living environment for these teenagers, allowing them to reintegrate into society with a renewed sense of purpose and direction.

身心障礙暨發展遲緩兒童服務

「早期發現、早期治療」、「以家庭為中心、社區為基礎」、「重視權益、社會融合」是我們早療服務的核心精神。自1992 年本會即展開身心障礙及發展遲緩兒童的早療服務，目前在新北市、台中、彰化、雲林成立 4 所發展學園，並在大同育幼院設立早療部，依據兒童及家庭的需求，訂定個別化服務計畫，讓兒童獲得適切的療育、家庭獲得支持。此外推展早療社區工作，讓離島及偏遠地區的家庭也能獲得幫助、社區能共同為兒童發展努力，期許慢飛天使在各界陪伴中展望更好的未來。

通報轉介中心

台中及雲林家扶發展學園受政府委託辦理通報轉介中心，服務內容為受理有發展疑慮幼童的通報、提供早療諮詢、資源轉介與宣導服務，期能確實掌握幼兒現況、協助幼兒及早接受療育，並宣導社會大眾及家長對兒童發展與早期療育的基本認識。2023 年本服務新增通報 2,021 名，並辦理 32 場次宣導篩檢活動。

個案管理服務

以受理通報轉介個案為主要服務對象，依兒童個別需求，規劃一系列服務計畫，整合家庭內外資源、幫助兒童有效發揮潛能。2023 年於台中、彰化及雲林家扶發展學園提供 3,780 名兒童個案管理服務，其中新增個案 1,504 人、結案 1,931 人；服務內容以諮詢服務為主，提供 5,908 次服務。

療育服務

細分為「機構時段療育服務、到宅療育服務、社區療育及社區關懷工作」。

・ 機構時段療育服務

提供職能、物理、語言、認知、音樂等課程，依照兒童個別需求，提供更彈性且適當的時段安排。2023 年在新北市、台中、雲林家扶發展學園、馬祖家扶中心及大同育幼院提供 2,492 人次時段療育服務。

・ 到宅療育服務

透過專業人員到家中親自示範教養照顧技巧，指導主要照顧者如何在家中協助兒童進行療育，在其熟悉的環境中促進發展能力。2023 年共計提供 3,481 人次到宅療育服務。

・ 社區療育及社區關懷工作

2023 年提供 13,385 人次社區療育及社區關懷；彰化、雲林發展學園以駐點和走動式據點的服務提供療育和家庭支持服務，台中發展學園、馬祖家扶中心、新北市淡水服務處及大同育幼院則以社區關懷服務方案引介資源，將服務觸角伸入較偏遠或早療資源較少的社區，提升有需要的家庭接近療育資源的機會，並透過團體、講座和家庭諮詢，增進親職能力。

日間托育服務

新北市、台中、彰化、雲林家扶發展學園及大同育幼院有提供日間托育服務，讓特殊需求兒童於日間安置至機構園所，由專業人員進行托育照顧、教學與治療，並依照兒童發展需求，定期擬定個別化服務計畫。2023 年累計服務 262 名身心障礙兒童、53 名發展遲緩兒童。

特力服務方案

提供已進入小學的學齡身心障礙兒童及家庭有支持協助服務，目前於台中發展學園、南台南、台東家扶中心及大同育幼院進行服務推廣，主要提供家庭培力與支持、兒童培力與權益落實，以及社區培力與合作 ... 等計畫，確保特殊需求兒童及照顧者有穩定的發展、教育和參與社會機會與支援，減輕生活壓力。



Services for Children with Physical and Mental Disabilities and Developmental Delays

The core principles of our early intervention services are “early detection, early treatment,” “family-centered, community-based,” and “emphasis on rights, social inclusion.” Since 1992, our organization has been dedicated to providing early intervention services for children with physical and mental disabilities and developmental delays. We have established four development centers in New Taipei City, Taichung, Changhua, and Yunlin, as well as an Early Intervention Department at Ta-Tung Children’s Home. Tailored individual service plans are devised based on the needs of the children and their families, ensuring that children receive appropriate therapeutic services and their families receive support. We also promote early intervention community services so that families on outlying islands and in remote areas can also receive assistance. By fostering community efforts toward child development, we aim for our “slow-flying angels” to envision a better future with the support of all sectors.

Reporting and Referral Center

The Taichung and Yunlin Child Development Centers have been entrusted by the government to manage the reporting and referral centers. Their services include receiving reports of children with developmental concerns, providing early intervention consultations, resource referrals, and advocacy services. These efforts aim to accurately monitor the current condition of young children, assist them in receiving timely therapy, and educate the public and parents about child development and early intervention. In 2023, there were 2,021 new reports received and 32 advocacy and screening events conducted.

Case Management Service

The main target of the service is to accept referral cases for further assistance and series of service programs are planned according to the individual needs of children. We integrate internal and external resources of the family and help children effectively develop their potential. In 2023, the case management services were provided for 3,780 children in Taichung, Changhua and Yunlin Children Development Centers. Among them, there were 1,504 new cases and 1,931 closed cases. The service mainly consisted of counseling, providing a total of 5,908 sessions.



Intervention Services

Intervention Services include Center-based Intervention, Home-based Interventions, and Community-based Interventions and community care.

• Center-based Interventions

We provide courses on functions, physics, language, cognition, music, etc., and offer more flexible and appropriate time slots according to the individual needs of children. In 2023, there was a total of 2,492 person-times we served in New Taipei City, Taichung and Yunlin Child Development Centers, Matsu Branch, and Ta-Tung Children’s Home.

• Home-based Interventions

Professionals personally demonstrate parenting and care skills at home, instruct the main caregivers on how to assist children in the treatment at home, and enhance the development of abilities in their familiar environment. In 2023, there was a total of 3,481 person-times that we provided the home-based service.

• Community-based Interventions and community care

In 2023, a total of 13,385 individuals received community-based intervention service and community care. Changhua and Yunlin Child Development Centers provided rehabilitation and family support services through stationed and mobile service stations. Meanwhile, Taichung Child Development Center, Matsu Branch Office, Tamsui Service Center of New Taipei City and Ta-Tung Children’s Home introduced resources through community care service programs, extending services to communities with limited early intervention resources or those in more remote areas. This initiative aimed to increase opportunities for families in need to access intervention resources, and to enhance parenting skills through group activities, lectures, and family consultations.

Day Care Service

TFCF provides day care services in New Taipei City, Taichung, Changhua, and Yunlin Child Development Centers as well as Ta-Tung Children’s Home. These services allow children with special needs to be placed in institutional settings during the day, where they are cared for, taught, and treated by professional staff. Individualized service plans are regularly developed based on the developmental needs of the children. As of 2023, a total of 262 children with disabilities and 53 children with developmental delays have been served.

Support for Child and Family in Special Needs

Provide support and assistance services for schoolage children with disabilities and their families who have entered elementary school. Currently, services are being promoted at the Taichung Child Development Center, Southern Tainan and Taitung Branch Offices and Ta-Tung Children’s Home. The main projects include family empowerment and support, child empowerment and rights implementation, and community empowerment and cooperation. These initiatives aim to ensure that children with special needs and their caregivers have stable development, education, and opportunities for social participation and support, thereby alleviating their life pressures.



社區興力計畫

Community Service Program

「照顧一個孩子，需要整個社區的力量。」2023 年總計有 38 個社區興力計畫，服務 2,383 場次、服務超過 5 萬人次。由各縣市家扶中心於服務據點範圍內，擇定一個社區範圍，以社區整體兒少需求為出發，扎根社區提供服務。

It takes the whole community in caring for a child. In 2023, a total of 38 community service programs were implemented, comprising 2,383 sessions and serving over 50,000 individuals. Our branch offices in countries and cities selects a community within its service area and roots itself in the community to provide services, starting from the overall needs of children and youth in the community.



桃園家扶中心 - 希望·溪旺

Community Service Program of Hope by TFCF Taoyuan Branch Office

提到大溪兩個字，不免跟老街、豆干、木藝等等觀光元素產生聯想，為提升服務之可近性，桃園家扶中心於 2014 年 11 月設立大溪服務處，在服務過程中，發現許多學業低成就、低自我價值的學生，因此成立「溪旺工藝班」，以兒少培力為宗旨，讓孩子探索自己的興趣與建立自信心。

「溪旺工藝班」導入資源並連結社區居民的力量，共同豐富孩子們的成長歷程，安排植物纖維手工藝品、紙藝品、繪畫、印度彩繪、木工、金工、皮革等等多元課程。亦規劃多樣性的親子活動，提供社區民眾一個增進親子互動的活動場域。

宜蘭家扶中心 - FUN OH 社區據點

FUN OH Community Service Station by TFCF Yilan Branch Office

南方澳社區位於蘭陽平原南端盡頭，以漁業與觀光為主，隨著 80 年代漁業資源衰退，社區人口也逐漸外移，且南方澳地區外配子女比例高、位置封閉、資源不多，缺乏課後活動空間。

故 2017 年設立南方澳工作站 - FUN OH！南方澳社區據點，建立社區安全的活動空間，可就近推動兒少服務，增加社區兒少在課後、假日期間參與正向活動之機會，並以開放空間、多元活動來拓展兒少視野，培力兒少從經驗中學習，發展其獨特的生命經驗。

生活與生存協助 Livelihood Support

對於生活在貧窮線下的家庭，日常支出是主要壓力來源，如水電費、飲食、房租、兒童的學雜費等。本會透過每月提供扶助金或物資，讓家庭在龐大經濟壓力下有喘息空間；在地社工員定期訪視，給予家長們情緒支持，也藉由諸商技巧找出家庭的優勢，鼓勵家長穩定就業，提升家庭收入讓孩子有更好的生活環境。2023年蒙古、吉爾吉斯、柬埔寨與菲律賓中心提供扶助金予家庭；史瓦帝尼中心依當地民情補助社區及學校。各中心亦順應國情與家庭狀況提供生活物資，推估影響超過 53,252 人。

緊急醫療、喪葬、重大意外事件…等突發急難事件會讓貧困家庭的經濟情形雪上加霜。故本會在扶助家庭遭逢變故的第一時間提供支持與協助，與家庭共度難關。2023年提供急難救助 387 件，其中以醫療支持占最高比例。

隨著時代變遷，缺乏一技之長的家長僅能從事勞動密集產業，或擔任缺乏保障的臨時工，難以提升家庭收入。為改善此困境，2023 年共計協助 214 名家長與學生參與職業訓練。吉爾吉斯進行家長縫紉班和美容美髮班；史瓦帝尼針對婦女製作的商品進行販售；柬埔寨進行回收資源再製商品及居家植栽技術；約旦進行木工、香氛皂、烹飪課程等等；菲律賓進行烘培課程。

特色方案「吉爾吉斯 - 牲生不息」透過家庭的農畜專長，以牲畜生產循環減緩民生負擔。經畜牧課程訓練後選出 3 戶表現最為優異之家庭，並分別提供每戶家庭 1 頭牛、7 隻羊、飼料和牧草。

As far as families under the poverty line are concerned, the daily expenses, such as bills for water and electricity, food, house rent and tuition fees for children, are the major sources of economic stress. Monthly subsidies in cash or in kind are provided by TFCF oversea branch offices, so that the families could catch their breath under immense economic stress. The local social workers pay visits to offer emotional support to parents. While identifying the strengths of these families, the social workers encourage a stable employment for the parents to raise the household income and offer the kids a better living condition. In 2023, TFCF Branch Offices in Mongolia, Kyrgyzstan, Cambodia, and the Philippines provided families with support in cash, and TFCF Eswatini Branch Office provided subsidies to the communities and schools catering to the local needs. All the branch offices offered daily supplies in line with the respective conditions of the countries and families as well, creating impacts to an estimate of over 53,252 individuals.

Medical emergencies, funeral services, critical accidents, and other emergencies, would plunge the conditions of families in poverty from bad to worse. Hence, TFCF offers its support and assistance promptly upon emergencies for the sponsored families. A total of 387 cases were supported in 2023, among which medical relief accounted for the majority.

As time goes by, the parents that lack skills could only work in the labor-intensive industries, or work as temporary workers with lacked security, which pose challenges to household income improvement. To remedy the situation, vocational trainings were offered to 214 parents and students in 2023. The parent needlework program and hairdressing program were available in Kyrgyzstan. The products made by the women in Eswatini were put on sale. Programs like resources recycling for product making and home gardening techniques were available in Cambodia. The woodcraft program, scented soap program, cooking class, etc. were provided in Jordan. Baking classes were conducted in the Philippines.

The “Kyrgyzstan: Livestock Program”, by harnessing the agricultural and livestock expertise of families, relieved their economic burden through the production cycle of livestock. After completing livestock training courses, 3 families with the most outstanding performance were selected and provided each with 1 cattle, 7 sheep, feed, and pasture.

「糧食不安全」的狀況在開發中國家仍屬常見，尤其本會海外中心服務的偏鄉地區，取得食材的管道不多，價格落差大、貧困家庭僅能以最廉價之方式取得食材，使得攝取營養不均，扶助兒少的體重過輕或肥胖、身高低於平均值。

本會擬定營養改善方案，以補充扶助家庭糧食來源、促進營養均衡。2023 年在海外 7 個家扶中心發放澱粉類主食、乳製品、蛋豆魚肉類、蔬果、油脂以及調味品等等，滿足兒童在各成長階段的必要需求。除了發放食品及營養品，今年度也特別強調篩檢和課程的必要性，透過健康篩檢及早判斷孩童的健康狀態並提供必要協助。

農耕在史瓦帝尼仍是幫助扶助家庭確保糧食安全的主要方式。史瓦帝尼中心發展「開心農場方案」，提供所需資源如設備、菜苗、農藥、堆肥，以及耕種培訓，讓社區居民在社區空地種菜，2023 年 5 個社區順利收穫 232 公斤的農產品。

醫療服務與公共衛生方面，本會持續在蒙古、吉爾吉斯、史瓦帝尼、越南、柬埔寨、菲律賓提供醫療照護，回應當地醫療資源匱乏所衍生的醫療需求；亦透過衛生教育等方式，持續提升服務對象的對健康意識，共計服務 13,974 人。

“Food insecurity” remains a common issue in developing countries, especially in the rural areas served by the TFCF overseas branch offices. The access to food is limited with huge price gaps. The families in poverty could only afford the cheapest food ingredients that render ill-balanced nutrition intake as well as underweight, overweight, or stunting in sponsored children.

TFCF came up with the Nutrition Improvement Program to complement the food sources and facilitate a balanced nutrition for sponsored families. Our 7 overseas branch offices distributed starch-based staples, dairy products, eggs, beans, fish, meat, fruits, vegetables, oils, and seasonings in 2023, so as to meet the necessities of sponsored children across all stages of growth. In addition to distributing food and nutrition supplements, TFCF also attached huge importance to screening and education this year. Through health screenings and early assessment of children's health conditions, necessary assistance is provided.

Farming remains to be a primary means to ensure food security for the sponsored families in Eswatini. The TFCF Eswatini Branch Office develops the “Happy Farm Program” to supply necessary resources like equipment, seedlings, pesticides, composts, and farming training, so that community residents could farm at the empty spaces of the communities. 5 communities successfully harvested 232kg of produce in 2023.

As for medical and public health services, TFCF continued to provide medical care in Mongolia, Kyrgyzstan, Eswatini, Vietnam, Cambodia, and the Philippines to meet the medical needs arising from insufficient medical resources locally. Also, we unceasingly raised the health awareness of the beneficiaries through measures like health education and other measures. The medical services were accessed by 13,974 individuals.



教育與學習支持

Education and Learning Support

為了滿足發展中國家弱勢孩童的就學需求，本會積極推動教育與學習支持方案。2023 年透過學用品補充方案提供了 38,743 份學用品，其中 89% 為一般學用品、6% 為書包、4% 為制服，另有 2% 為摺疊桌和眼鏡等就學所需用品。

以大專生為主要發放對象，提供獎助學金，減少求學階段的經濟壓力，共發放了 821 份獎助學金。海外學生培育計畫也持續進行，2023 年有 1 名蒙古籍學生順利畢業並返回母國就業。

因應各國兒少年齡層和文化需求，能力建構方案發展出不同的服務與規模，提供課後輔導、營隊活動、青年構力、才藝培訓、兒童早期發展等，共計 6,477 人受惠。

在開發中國家，取得課外讀物並不容易。為了培養兒少閱讀習慣，蒙古、吉爾吉斯、史瓦帝尼、柬埔寨中心推行書香方案以採購或募捐等方式，擴充校園或社區讀書角的藏書，並且舉辦閱讀活動以鼓勵兒少參與，本年度共計 28,255 人次受惠。



To accommodate the educational needs of disadvantaged children in developing countries, TFCF proactively promotes education and learning support programs. In 2023, through the educational supplies programs, TFCF provided 38,743 school supplies in total, in which 89% were common school supplies, 6% were schoolbags, 4% were uniforms, and 2% were folding tables, glasses and other school supplies.

We primarily targeted college students and provided scholarships to alleviate financial pressure during their academic pursuits. A total of 821 scholarships were awarded. The Overseas Students Cultivation Program also continued its efforts in 2023, with one student from Mongolia successfully graduating and returning to their home country for employment.

In line with the age groups and cultural needs of children in different countries, capacity building programs were developed varied in service and in scale, such as after-school tutoring, camps, youth empowerment, talent incubation, and childhood development, etc. A total of 6,477 individuals have benefited from these programs.

Extracurricular readings are hard to come by in developing countries. To cultivate reading habits of children and youth, reading programs are promoted by TFCF Branch Offices in Mongolia, Kyrgyzstan, Eswatini, and Cambodia to expand the book collections on campuses or in communities through procurement or donations. Also, reading activities were organized to encourage participation of children and youth. There were up to 28,255 accesses to the programs this year.

社會與環境改善 Social and Environmental Improvement

發展中國家面臨水資源匱乏的窘境，取得乾淨水源成為弱勢家庭和社區的一大挑戰。今年除了維護既有的供水站，蒙古中心新建 1 座智慧型供水站，觸及社區內 2,295 戶家庭，也應當地水利局邀請，捐贈供水車 1 台，讓 5 個社區能使用乾淨的水。

史瓦帝尼中心為 2 間認養學校修繕供水站，並協助 2 個認養社區分別修繕水塔和水井，合計 940 人受益。並支援 1 個認養社區購置儲水塔，服務觸及 120 人，且在 2 個認養社區進行濾水器使用訓練，觸及 20 戶家庭。史瓦帝尼中心亦分別在認養學校 440 以及認養社區 333 興建現代化的沖水式廁所，減少排泄物堆積而產生的異味和衛生問題，合計觸及 404 人。

安全住所是生活的基本需求，也是家人情感聯結與個人安全感的主要來源。為使扶助家庭擁有穩定良好的居住環境，今年在住宅支持方案總計協助 97 戶家庭整修或重建住所。蒙古中心提供蒙古包及蒙古包物件給 55 戶家庭，並提供樹苗給 114 戶家庭種植以供綠化環境。在吉爾吉斯、史瓦帝尼、約旦和菲律賓協助興建或修繕 42 戶房子，改善居住環境。今年除了房屋結構的修繕，減少漏水和強風入侵等情況，部分國家則有安裝暖氣、更換防火材料等服務，改善居住品質和安全性。

蒙古中心的家扶村共服務 11 戶家庭；吉爾吉斯中心經營的社區體育館提供在地民眾良好運動空間，也用作社區足球友誼賽或者中心足球隊訓練及活動之場地；柬埔寨中心持續經營 3 個直接扶助社區的服務據點，做為社區讀書角、方案及活動場地使用；菲律賓中心改善 Addition Hills 社區 6 個街區既有設施，強調各角色責任的加強與分工。

Developing countries face water scarcity, making access to clean water a major challenge for disadvantaged families and communities. This year, in addition to maintaining existing water stations, the TFCF Mongolia Branch Office has also built 1 new smart water station, reaching 2,295 households in the community. At the request of the local water authority, one water supply truck was donated to enable five communities to have access to clean water.

The TFCF Eswatini Branch Office renovated water stations for 2 sponsored schools and assisted 2 sponsored communities with repairing water towers and wells, benefiting a total of 940 individuals. In addition, 1 sponsored community was supported to purchase water tanks, with services reaching 120 individuals. A water filter training was carried out in 2 sponsored communities, reaching 20 households. The TFCF Eswatini Branch Office also built modern flush toilets in Sponsored School 440 and Neighborhood Care Point 333, respectively, to reduce the odor and sanitation issues caused by excrement accumulation, reaching a total of 404 individuals.

Safe housing is a fundamental need in life as well as the primary source of emotional connection for families and a sense of personal security. To ensure that the sponsored families have a stable and healthy living environment, the housing support program helped a total of 97 households renovate or rebuild their homes this year. The TFCF Mongolia Branch Office provided yurts and yurt supplies to 55 households, and seedlings for 114 households to plant for landscaping. In Kyrgyzstan, Eswatini, Jordan and the Philippines, our branch offices assisted in building or renovating 42 houses to improve living conditions. This year, apart from renovating house structure to reducing leaks and wind intrusion, services like heater installation and fire-retardant materials replacement were delivered in certain countries to improve the quality and safety of housing.

The TFCF Village of the TFCF Mongolia Branch Office served a total of 11 households this year. The community gymnasium operated by the TFCF Kyrgyzstan Branch Office offered a good sports space for local residents, which was also used as a venue for community football friendly matches or for the training and exercising of the TFCF football team. The TFCF Cambodia Branch Office continued to operate the community service stations for 3 direct service communities, which served the purposes of community reading, programs, and activities venues. The TFCF Philippines Branch Office improved the existing facilities in 6 blocks of the Addition Hills community, with an emphasis on the strengthening and division of labor among different roles.

Additionally, a social game "428 Child Protection Bingo Challenge" was developed to educate people on avoiding online traps and preventing child abuse cases.

Independent Auditors' Report

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Taiwan Fund for Children and Families (the "TFCF"), which comprise the balance sheets as of December 31, 2023 and 2022, and the statements of income and expenditure, changes in net value and cash flows for the years then ended, and the notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the TFCF as of December 31, 2023 and 2022, and its financial performance and its cash flows for the years then ended in accordance with the Foundations Act, the National Social Welfare Consortium Accounting and Financial Reporting Standards, the Business Entity Accounting Act, and the Regulation on Business Entity Accounting Handling, the provisions relating to the preparation of financial statements and generally accepted accounting principles.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audits in accordance with the Regulations Governing Auditing and Attestation of Financial Statements by Certified Public Accountants and auditing standards in of the Republic of China. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the TFCF in accordance with The Norm of Professional Ethics for Certified Public Accountant of the Republic of China, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the Foundations Act, the National Social Welfare Consortium Accounting and Financial Reporting Standards, the Business Entity Accounting Act, and the Regulation on Business Entity Accounting Handling, the provisions relating to the preparation of financial statements and generally accepted accounting principles, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the TFCF's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the TFCF or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance, including the supervisor, are responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditors' report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with the auditing standards in of the Republic of China will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with the auditing standards in of the Republic of China, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

1. Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not

detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

2. Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the TFCF's internal control.
3. Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.

If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditors' report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditors' report. However, future events or conditions may cause the TFCF to cease to continue as a going concern.
5. Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

家扶簡史

Brief History

1938 年

為拯救中國對日抗戰中的戰亂孤兒，美國傳教士卡維特·克拉克博士 (J.Calvitt Clarke) 於美國維琴尼亞州里其蒙市 (Richmond, Virginia) 設立中國兒童基金會 (China's Children Fund，簡稱 CCF)，並在中國大陸各地開辦 42 所育幼院。

To rescue the war orphans during the Sino-Japanese War, Dr. J. Calvitt Clarke, an American Presbyterian minister, established the China's Children Fund (CCF) in Richmond, Virginia, U.S.A and set up 42 orphanages across mainland China.

1950 年

美國 CCF 於台灣成立第一所家庭式育幼院 - 台中光音育幼院，主要由美、加教會人士捐助經費提供服務，本會在台灣的兒童福利工作於焉展開。

CCF established Children's Cottage Home, Kwang-In as the 1st family-style orphanage in Taiwan setting the foundation for our services and programs.
